



Preparation of Abstract for the International Congress on Artificial Intelligence in Medical Sciences

ABSTRACT

The abstract of an article should be a clear, concise, and accurate summary, **having 200-350 words**, and including the explicit sub-headings (**headings in bold**). It should be single-spaced in 11-point Times New Roman. Using abbreviations should be avoided and the references should not be cited in the abstract. Ideally, each abstract should include the following sub-headings:

Background and aims: Include one or two sentences to introduce the broad topic area and provide a reason for the study then a clear statement of the study's aim. A hypothesis could be included in this section.

Method: Your abstract should also describe the research methods. Typically, this would include some mention of the participants involved (the sample), equipment, and procedures.

Results: Describe the main study findings and direct study outputs.

Conclusion: In this section, you should provide statements of interpretation and implication of findings. It should not be a simple re-statement of the results. Any important suggestions for relevance to the field or further work that must be carried out can be stated here.

The abstract should be submitted in the format of MS Word (.doc or .docx) document. Keywords should be given leaving a one-line space below this text.

Keywords: artificial intelligence, medicine, writing, template, first (maximum 6 words)

Important Notes

- All sections of the abstract submission, including the title, author names, affiliations, abstract text, and keywords, must be written in English only. No other languages will be accepted.
- Submitted articles should not have been previously published or be under review elsewhere.
- The Congress Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject, accept, or request revisions for submitted articles.
- Deadline for article submission: [4 December].
